Rose Bowl Parade 2022

The Kiwanis Rose Float District Committee of the California-Nevada-Hawaii District of Kiwanis International raised funds and provided volunteers to build the Kiwanis International float and nine additional floats for the 2022 Rose Bowl Parade.

The committee recruited more than 4,000 volunteers from Kiwanis clubs, Builders Clubs, Key Clubs, and Circle K. These volunteers put in 50,000-plus hours to ensure the 10 floats were ready for the annual parade.

This year's theme "Dream to Achieve" included Tommy the Turtle towing a "dream boat" guiding children to follow their dreams in order to achieve a positive future. The floats were all decorated with organic materials. For example, the green on Tommy the Turtle was created by using parsley, brussels sprouts, split peas, and limes. This float symbolizes the Kiwanis mission of improving the lives of children in our communities.
